Frank Madden stands out as one of the most successful and dedicated trainers of young and developing show jumping talent in the United States. He has trained several of the most promising junior equitation and junior amateur jumper riders - riders who have the potential to represent the United States at the highest levels of international competition.

Frank Madden and several of his top riders were featured in the 2005 Animal Planet television series "Horse Power: The Road to the Maclay." Animal Planet filmed as Brianne Goutal made history as the first junior rider to win all the major equitation finals with her 2005 wins in both the USEF Medal Finals and the ASPCA Maclay Finals. His riders also earned the coveted "Style of Riding" awards at such shows as the Washington International and the Devon Horse Shows as well as winning top honors in all of this country's major finals and championships year after year. The training ring, however, is just one area in which Frank Madden contributes to the development of American show jumping. In addition to Frank's previous work producing the "Wachovia Jumper Classic at Beacon Hill", Frank serves on several national committees, is on the Board of Directors for the Syracuse Invitational Sporthorse Tournament, and frequently donates his time and expertise by judging, giving clinics, and developing potential sponsors for the sport. Frank's efforts have been recognized in various awards and honors such as Frank's prestigious. Developmental Coach of the Year" award from the United States Olympic Committee and Beacon Hill's designation as "Show Hunter Horseman of the Year for 2005" by The Chronicle of the Horse. In addition is serves on the board of USHJA Hunt Seat Equitation Task Force. In 2009, Frank Madden's riders successfully competed at Old Salem Farm, Lake Placid, Vermont and The Hampton Classic. In August, Sydney Shulman and Set Sail captured the Pony Jumper Championship at Pony Finals in Lexington, Kentucky. Danielle Cooper and Amalfi won the Junior Hunter Finals in Saugerties, New York and Gabrielle Bausano placed fifth in the Wolffer Estate Equitation Classic in Southampton, New York. Frank's riders began 2010 in excellent form at the Winter Equestrian Festival in Wellington, FL. Equitation riders Gabrielle Bausano, Emily Reynolds, and Victoria Birdsall competed in the prestigious George Morris Excellence in Equitation class, with Victoria taking home the top honors. Danielle Cooper and Amalfi carried their successes from 2009 into 2010, capturing the WEF Circuit Championship in the Amateur Owner Hunters 18-35. Additionally, Arriana Boardman and Gatsby performed consistently and successfully in the Adult Amateur Hunter division to capture the Circuit Championship.
